

## **CITATION RULES**

This is a program whereby the BAA keeps records of who holds the distinction of having taken fish species that meet the established minimum weight of these species by means of the bow and arrow.

Rules are as follows:

1. Must be a BAA member prior to the issuance of citation.
2. There will be a \$3.00 registration fee.
3. These records will be kept on file by the BAA and are available for inspection at any time.
4. The entrant must furnish the BAA with a picture of the fish next to a measurable object (preferably yourself), and a signed affidavit by two witnesses stating that they were present at the time of said weighing.
5. All entrants to be considered for a BAA State Record or a BAA Big Fish of the Year award must be weighed on an accurate scale.
6. All entrants to be considered for a BAA World Record must be weighed on a certified scale.
7. Applications must be turned in within 30 days after the fish was harvested to acquire points for Bowfisherman of the Year. All other citations can be turned at any time. The Points year is from September 1st to August 31st, with a 30 day grace period after August 31st to file the application.
8. The BAA will give a State Record citation for the largest fish taken in each category, in each State.
9. The BAA will give a bar patch (for displaying under your BAA patch) for the largest fish taken in each category, for each state, in each year (September 1 - August 31).
10. Incomplete applications will not receive any points.
11. All citations and awards will be listed in the Bowfishing Journal.
